





# Miromar Lakes' Landscaping awash in reds, pinks, purples, orchids and hibiscus

A kaleidoscope of color awaits residents at nearly every turn as they walk, jog, bike and drive around Miromar Lakes' streets and neighborhoods.

The flowers have been popping after a sprinkling of rain and warming sunshine. There are pink geraniums in handmade Mexican terra cotta pots throughout the community... Alyssum and pink tophat begonias along Miromar Lakes Parkway... sweet-scented, silver and purple Texas sage and red Barbara Karst bougainvillea along Lake Como Way.

Outside the neighborhoods, you'll see pink impatiens by Anacapri and Castelli... orange sunpatiens and purple Mexican petunias by Costa del Lago. ... pink ice oleanders across from Volterra and lavender and mystic spire salvia across from Ravenna partierre. There are pink and purple Curly Qs sunpatients around the Peninsula Fountain by Portofino. And by the Marina on the Peninsula, there's hibiscus and a variety of the potted and trellis bougainvillea climbing plants.



Red rose glow and orchid blush sunpatiens also dot the surroundings.

"When you create an area, you don't want a sensory overload, but you do want to get people pulled in," Miromar Lakes landscape manager Robert Celatka said. "Even if you've looked at the flowers for a while, you'll still see different things if you keep looking."

Meanwhile, there's more than 3,000 plants at the Botanical Park with such names as Brazilian Beauty Leaf, Podocarpus Maki, Heliconia Choconiana, Mediterranean Fan Palm, Queen Emma Crinum Lily, Japanese Privet, Calypso Red Oleander, Saw Palmetto and Blue Plumbago.

You can see why the Botanical Park won the 2020 Pinnacle Award for Best Landscape Design. And that's just another big reason why Miromar Lakes has been named the #1 Community in the U.S.
